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What exactly is a Naming Ceremony?

...and why have one?

A Naming Ceremony is a very special way of celebrating the birth of your child. It's a unique and meaningful event that's designed to welcome your child into the family and to celebrate his or her place in the wider community.

Who conducts a Naming Ceremony?

Most people elect to have their ceremony conducted by a professional Celebrant. However, you can choose to have it led by someone you know instead. We offer a script-only service for people who wish to do this.

All our Celebrants are specially trained professionals. A Celebrant will arrange to meet you beforehand to discuss your ceremony and will deliver it according to the choices you make. Your Celebrant's primary goal is to ensure that your ceremony runs smoothly and that you have a truly memorable day.



What happens at the ceremony?

It's your ceremony and you choose what goes into it. However, the structure of your ceremony will include:

Welcome

The Celebrant makes an introduction and welcomes your guests.

Reading(s)

Appropriate poems or readings, the first being near the start of the ceremony and what it is about. You can select further readings for later in the ceremony as well.

Naming of the Child or Children

The Celebrant asks you to confirm the full name you've given to your child and, if you wish, to offer the reasons for your choices.

Parents' Promises

This is the part of the ceremony where you promise, in words of your choosing, to be as good a parent as you can be. You can also take the opportunity to make promises of commitment to your partner.

Supporting Adults' & Grandparents' Promises

Choose as many friends or relatives to be your child's Supporting Adults as you feel appropriate. During the ceremony they will make declarations of love and ongoing support to your child. Grandparents can also be involved by pledging their support.

Closing Words

After a further reading, and the presentation of any gifts, the Celebrant closes the ceremony with phrases of your choosing. You are then presented with a special commemorative certificate, which is signed by the Celebrant and those who have taken part in the ceremony.

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The Classic Naming Ceremony

Whichever ceremony package you decide upon, your ceremony will be unique because it will comprise your choices.

- Choose a second reading, either from a selection provided in the booklet or one of your own choosing.
- Select the Closing Words from a choice of phrases provided.

The Classic option is a straightforward and well structured ceremony. It provides a wonderful centrepiece to a wider family event. The ceremony guide provides you with selections of key phrases from which you make appropriate choices to create your completed ceremony script. A script-only service is available if you don't require a professional Celebrant.

Where can the ceremony be held?

You can hold your ceremony at any suitable venue. The venue does not have to be licensed in any way, nor does it have to be local to you. Perhaps you have a hotel in mind, or maybe a favourite restaurant or a village hall. Of course, you might prefer to hold the ceremony at home, or at a friend's or relative's house (subject to suitability). Ceremonies can be held outside but there will need to be an inside room available in case of bad weather.

Your questions answered . . .

How much does a ceremony cost?

(All prices quoted include VAT)

A Classic Ceremony costs just £168. If you prefer not to have a professional Celebrant involved in the delivery of the ceremony, the script-only option costs £55.

A Bespoke Ceremony costs just £265. This includes the fully tailor made script. The script-only option is £110. These prices also apply to the Birthday ceremony.

Please note that if you wish to have your ceremony at home the Celebrant is required to first carry out a Health & Safety assessment, for which we have to charge a fee of £30.



What does the cost of a ceremony provide?

- The services of a Celebrant (if chosen) both before and during the ceremony.
- Creation of a unique ceremony script (a full tailor made script for a Bespoke Ceremony).
- Exclusive ceremony and event planning guides if choosing a Custom Ceremony.
- A dedicated Bespoke Ceremony Team if choosing a Bespoke Ceremony.
- A commemorative certificate of the ceremony.

How long does the ceremony last?

This depends on how much you choose to include. A Classic Ceremony generally lasts between fifteen and thirty minutes. Since a Bespoke Ceremony is more involving it usually lasts between twenty and forty-five minutes. Do remember that the ceremony itself is part of a potentially much bigger family event. There are countless additional activities you can arrange to add to the overall success of the whole day.

Can it contain religion?

If there are religious readings or references that have special meaning for you, you are welcome to include them at any point in a Bespoke Ceremony. For a Classic Ceremony the optional second reading offers you an opportunity to include any religious or spiritual content.

Does the ceremony carry any legal status?

Neither the Naming Ceremony nor any document issued as a result of it has any legal status whatsoever.

Can I include other children in the ceremony?

Feel free to include your other children - your ceremony can be for more than one child from within your family at no additional cost.

Who can arrange a ceremony?

A ceremony can be arranged by the child's parents (either alone or jointly), or by a legal guardian. There is no requirement for the parents to be married.

Can we organise a ceremony at short notice?

You need to allow six weeks to create a Bespoke Ceremony, but a Classic Ceremony can be arranged at short notice. It is always best to plan your ceremony as far in advance as possible.
